The reviews of Injury on Duty Pension Awards is still on-going and I have recently posted the latest update from the Force on the Staffordshire NARPO Website under the ADVICE section.

I am also exchanging correspondence with the Information Commissioners Office (ICO) in Cheshire following an issue that was raised by a NARPO Member regarding Staffordshire Police and the Pension Administrator, XPS, outsourcing the printing of our payslips and P60's to a third- party

printers, potentially without informing our members. I am currently awaiting a reply from the ICO, and I will update you when I have received the result of their investigation.

Nationally, the NEC of NARPO are promoting the issue that NARPO should become an Incorporated Body, which in effect turns NARPO into a limited company. There may be advantages of this, as well as disadvantages, and to this end National NARPO are holding several seminars around the country which are being facilitated by Bernard Seymour our retained Legal Advisor. At the conclusion of these seminars the matter will then be discussed at NARPO's National Conference in Blackpool on 9th September 2023 when a vote will be taken to decide if further work should be undertaken before a final decision is made over Incorporation.

May I also invite you to our own AGM which will take place at Staffordshire Police HQ, Weston Road, Stafford on Saturday, 18th March 2023, commencing 11:00 am. A key election of officers will include voting for a new Branch Treasurer following the retirement of Reay (Bruce) Pearman who has held the post for many years. Having been steward of the funds for so long you will note that his successor has a healthy fund to maintain on behalf of you all [See page 5]. Nominations for any of the executive positions, with seconders, to be submitted to the Branch Secretary in accordance with the Branch Rules.

Recruiting Advertisement for Policewomen 1945.

Policewomen Constables are wanted in the Staffordshire County Police to carry out the many and varied Police duties in which women, girls and children are especially involved.

Policewomen on joining the Force must be between 22 and 35 years of age, single or widows, and not less than 5ft 4 in in height, and of good physique.

The Service is pensionable and pay on appointment is 79 shillings weekly (f3.95p), rising by annual increments to 102 shillings weekly (£5.10p). Rent and other allowances are payable as laid down by the Police (Women) Regulations.

Much of the work is done in uniform, which is provided, and is smart and modern in design.

Prospects of promotion are good for women of intelligence and integrity, who show initiative and qualities of leadership.

Applications should be sent to the Chief Constable of Staffordshire at the Police Headquarters, Eastgate Street, Stafford.

Security of Members Data

A member of the Branch Committee in Staffordshire NARPO on Thursday 23rd February 2023 became the victim of a fraudster who got remote access to the victims personal computer. Though a small chance, the offender had the opportunity to access a file containing other NARPO members personal details, which is legitimately held by this member for NARPO business.

The member properly reported to Narpo the potential breach. Analysis of the Log Files by a security consultant does not show that the fraudster actually accessed the file, but it cannot be ignored that the file (and others on the computer) was there at the time.

The Narpo Data Protection Officer, and Information Commissioners Office (ICO) were notified, in accordance with our established policy and procedures. The ICO is satisfied with the actions taken and issued general advice.

All members are urged to treat with suspicion unsolicited letters, phone calls, email messages, social media messages, text messages from anyone that is unexpected. Do not allow anyone else to have remote access to your computer/phone/device by permitting them to activate a screen sharing tool. Additional security measures have been adopted and further training is now available for the Branch Committee members who hold member information.

Bowel Cancer Screening

Many members in their 60s will have been offered the service of Bowel Cancer Screening. Be aware this service is not routinely offered when you reach age 75 years.

If you wish to continue to be checked, you have to request a test kit.

You use a home test kit, called a faecal immunochemical test (FIT), to collect a small sample of poo and send it to a lab. This is checked for tiny amounts of blood.

Make sure your GP practice has your correct address so your kit is posted to the right place.

If you're 75 or over, you can ask for a kit every 2 years by phoning the free bowel cancer screening helpline on

0800 707 60 60.
