# Branch Subscriptions - A message about subscriptions from our Treasurer - Andy Drane

Thanks to all those who have paid your 2024 subscription. There are still a few outstanding and it will help if those are paid as soon as possible.

The minimum annual subscription is set by the NARPO National Executive Committee and is adjusted each January at the same rate as police pensions. For 2024, this is an increase to £26.28 (£24.60 in 2023). Chelmsford branch levies no more than this minimum amount.

If you pay by monthly deductions from your Essex Police pension, you need take no action as these have been adjusted automatically to £2.19 (previously £2.05). If you do not pay in this way, the whole amount of £26.28 is now due.

The preferred method of payment is via BACS (bank transfer) to the following account: The National Association of Retired Police Officers (Chelmsford) sort code 30-91-85 account number 01268114 quoting your initials and surname as the reference.
