When we began the Airwave study back in 2003, people communicated mostly by letter, telephone and fax. Since then, digital communication has become an important part of how we stay in touch. About 50% of our 53,000 cohort have provided us with an email address, and we would like to communicate with everyone this way. If you are a participant in the Airwave Study and haven't heard from us, it may be that the contact details we hold for you are outdated. HEARING TEST AT HOME
